## **CALL FOR POSTERS**

CN-CYR's primary purpose is to promote excellence in the provision of rehabilitation services for children, youth and their families.

We strive to present a coordinated, national voice for child and youth rehabilitation to ensure that children's rehabilitation and issues related to children with disabilities are on the forefront of the national health agenda. We seek to facilitate the creation of national interest groups on specific complex issues in child and youth rehabilitation that will focus on bringing research to practice. We are working towards the adoption of common data collection and outcome measurement tools.

The theme of our pre-conference session is ***Establishing National Data Collection and Outcomes Indicators Systems for Paediatric Rehabilitation: The Journey Continues.***

- We are requesting poster presentations that describe best practices in data collection and outcome measurement at a system, program, diagnostic and individual level.
- We are interested in any data collection initiatives utilized in your organization that describe who you serve and that potentially could form the beginning of a system of classification.
- We are also interested in any best practice initiatives that evaluate outcomes at the system, program, diagnostic and individual level or any example of outcome indicators that have proven useful within your organization or province.

***Selection criteria:*** The CN-CYR program committee will review submissions. If you additionally wish your poster to be considered for inclusion in the main CAPHC conference poster session please check the box on the application form and your submission will be automatically forwarded. We may have to restrict the number of posters because of space.

***Deadline for poster submissions:*** June 15, 2006  
***Notification of acceptance:*** July 15, 2006
