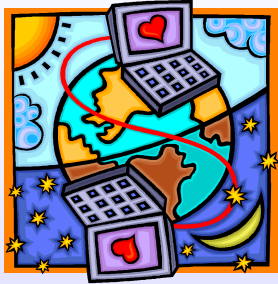

- Provide opportunities for therapeutic play and diversion.
- Prepare and support children and youth for medical tests and procedures.
- Support families.
- Initiate and sustain therapeutic relationships with patients and their families by using technology.
- Develop patient care plans in conjunction with the health care team.



CLICK Program Objectives

- Provide information and education about illness and medical condition.
- Decrease isolation by facilitating communication and social support with friends and siblings.
- Normalize the hospital environment
- Use distraction as a means to better manage pain and reduce stress.
- Facilitate accessing of information to increase coping through understanding and education.
- Provide supervision and assistance in order to maintain safe utilization.

Prioritizing Patients for the CLICK Program

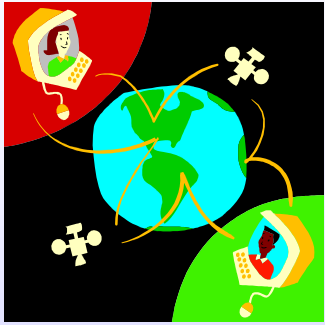
- Age of patient

Computer Program Therapeutic Interventions

- Peer support
- Communication with family members

- Diversion during medical procedures
- Web cam real time school attendance
