## Medical Officer – Paediatrics

The Department of Paediatrics and Child Health, Faculty of Medicine, University of Manitoba and the Child Health Program, Winnipeg Regional Health Authority are seeking three physicians to work as **Medical Officers** in Paediatrics at Children's Hospital, Health Sciences Centre, in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

The Children's Hospital serves the residents of Manitoba, northwestern Ontario, and southeastern Saskatchewan, a catchment area of over 1.5 million people. The hospital offers a unique experience to serve remote, rural and urban residents of this region.

Duties will include providing care to patients, under the supervision of an attending physician, admitted to either a paediatric oncology service or a general paediatric medicine teaching unit. Clinical duties in PICU (Paediatric Intensive Care) under the supervision of the paediatric intensivist may also be required.

### Qualifications:

Applicants must have 3 months experience in paediatric medicine and be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba.

### Salary:

An attractive compensation package is offered in concurrence with the current collective agreement between the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority and Doctors Manitoba.

Applications will be accepted until the positions are filled; early application is advised.
